QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION:

- How has education been "slaughtered"? What trends have created this problem?
- Do you agree that what we see now happening around us demonstrates the dangerous outcome of "nuanced" education that advances the anti-Israel rhetoric?
- Do you believe there is a defensiveness of Diaspora Jewry in accepting the mistakes made in education and community engagement?
- What can we learn from the hijacking of critical thinking by personal political bias that denies the rights of Israel and Jews in favor of the narrative of others?
- Jews who are anti-Israel claim that they refuse to accept the "Jewish version" of Israel's history. Now we are faced with the challenge of refuting that bias and encouraging them to not accept anti-Israel claims and manipulations out of a distorted desire for social justice. Why do you think Jews of today have been "pushed into a corner"? How can we shift the paradigm?
- "American Jews are paralyzed...if they say anything, they will be crucified for suffocating freedom of speech" - how would you respond?
- What portion of our fears are real, and what is "paranoia"?
- How can we manage our fears effectively without creating a detachment from the cause of those fears? How can we identify the causes and transform them into action?
- How could we approach social media as a tool for improved education and understanding surrounding Israel and Jewish rights?
